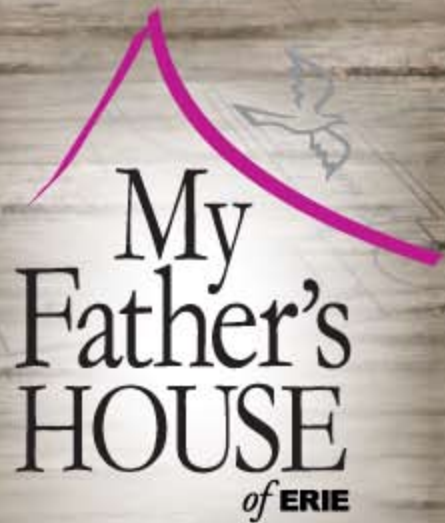
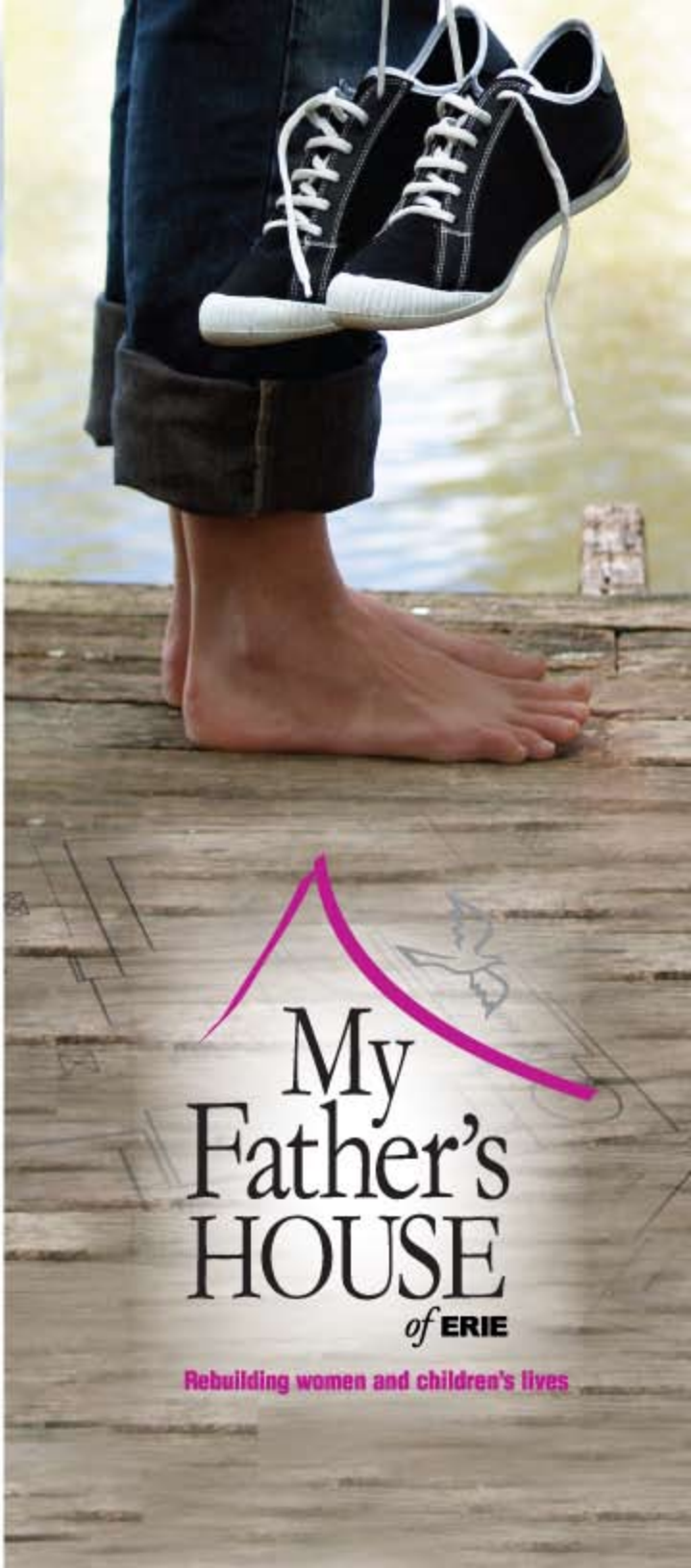

Time Frame:

My Father's House of Erie is an 18 month program. The services offered are centered on three major goals for the families:

1.) FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT:

The women will gain control of money matters by establishing a personal budget and become debt free.

2.) PERMANENT HOUSING:

The women will develop knowledge and understanding on how to attain and maintain permanent housing in the community. She will access home ownership training and secure matching funds through programs towards a down payment.

3.) HEALTHY RELATIONSHIPS:

The women will build healthy relationships with others. She will learn appropriate methods for empowering and managing her life-style through programing and social interactions.

Services:

My Father's House of Erie will provide residential accommodations with continuous twenty-four hour staff supervision. The services offered are:

- Present Housing / Transitional Living And Home Ownership
- Parenting Skills
- Health Care Assistance
- Personal Financial Management
- Employment/Vocational/Educational Development
- Child Care Services
- Activities For Daily Living
- Social & Interpersonal Relationship Skills



Mission:

My Father's House of Erie, incorporated in 1999, is a faith based 501(c)(3) non-profit transitional living home. It is our intention to assist women in reclaiming, restoring and redeeming their lives by providing a structured living environment and support services designed to help homeless and abused women and their children to transform their lives. This allows families to have successful, self-sufficient lives in a complex society.

Admissions:

The policy of My Father's House of Erie is to complete a intake to access program eligibility. Participation in the program is to be of a voluntary nature. Women can self refer, and referrals can come from a variety of sources in the community, such as social agencies, churches, families and friends. The women must be 18 years or older with or without children. The children's ages are from birth to 9 years old.
